Cadastral data is a framework of property boundaries along with associated land ownership information. Owner name, taxpayer mailing address and geocode information can all be located on the website. If you would like your name and information removed from the website, this form will need to be completed. This form is to be completed for each parcel of property from which you would like your name removed. Use the website address above to access the site and for assistance in completing the form. Please be aware that after removal of your information from the website, that information will remain for internal use on the Department's database for property assessment and tax administration purposes. Furthermore, the information will be available to local governments for tax administration purposes and to contractors and vendors who have agreements with the Department for the access to that information.

If you do not provide us an updated form upon the sale or transfer of the property, the Department cannot guarantee that the parcel information will remain off the cadastral.
