- Administers more than 30 state taxes and fees, including income, natural resource, corporation and miscellaneous taxes
- Establishes values for all taxable property, including agricultural land, residential property, commercial property, forest land, business equipment, railroads, public utilities and more
- Oversees the operation of agency liquor stores, manages the state wholesale liquor operations, and administers laws governing the sale, taxation and licensing of alcoholic beverages
- Returns unclaimed property and money to its rightful owners
