Revenue Department seeks volunteers to provide training to liquor establishments

Helena – The Montana Department of Revenue is seeking volunteers to help implement *Let's Control It*, the agency's training program for responsible alcohol sales and service. The volunteers would provide training to Montana liquor license holders about the state's requirements for selling and serving alcohol.
