MT Dept. of Revenue seeks volunteers to provide training to liquor establishments

HELENA – The Montana Department of Revenue would like to remind volunteers that March 31 is the deadline to apply for Let's Control It, the agency's training program for responsible alcohol sales and service. The volunteers will provide training to Montana liquor license holders on the state's requirements for selling and serving alcohol.

"For the past seven years, we've relied on volunteers to conduct our trainings and we really appreciate their efforts and the time they invest," said Department of Revenue Director Mike Kadas.

The department is accepting applications and supplemental questions until March 31.
